Procedure for applying for NOC for Short Term Inter State Open Access

- 1. File application in Format A along with all attachments including No Dues Certificate from Discom to CE, SLDC. Application can also be sent through email along with all attachments to noc oa@aptransco.gov.in Documents to be attached are:
 - a. Application in Format A
 - b. No Dues Certificate in Format B
 - c. Maximum Demand sanction order or last CC Bill copy By Consumer/Trader only
 - d. Notarized affidavit for UI undertaking
 - e. Notarized affidavit for RPPO undertaking (for the Consumers OA only)
- 2. Every First application from applicant will be sent to Discom concern for their remarks and technical feasibility. Hence applicant must file First application at least 30 working days in advance excluding day of filing application.
- 3. Second and subsequent applications if filed within 6 months of previous application, such application will not be sent to Discoms for remarks. Hence such applications must be filed at least 7 working days in advance excluding day of filing application.
- 4. However if second and subsequent application is filed beyond 6 months period from last application, such application must be filed at least 30 working days in advance excluding day of filing application.
- 5. Transco is planning software for Online Submission of application. Once it is launched, all applications must be filed Online only.
- 6. On approval of application for NOC, applicant will be informed through email.
