Sub: Migration of ERP System from SAP ECC to SAP S/4 HANA Cloud Platform -
Constitution of ERP Steering Committee (E-SCOM) — Orders Issued.

1. Implementation of SAP ERP System in TGTRANSCO was completed in 2016 and the new ERP System went live with effect from 01/09/2016. The product life of the present SAP ECC ERP Application (SAP-ECC 6.0 EHP 8) is coming to end by 31/12/2027 after which M/s SAP will not be providing the Annual Technical Support (ATS).
2. The SAP-ECC Software, which is an on premise version hosted and implemented on the HPE servers in the Data Centre at Vidyut Soudha, has completed 10 years of service. The servers are also getting old. Presently, M/s HPE are providing Annual Maintenance Support which is the process of being extended up to 14/03/2027. Considering the end of product life of the ERP software application and the HPE Servers, there is need for migration to the latest version of SAP ERP System for smooth continuation of the business processes.
3. Further, M/s SAP has made a major shift in its business model by phasing out the SAP-ECC software application as a Product and replacing the same with S/4 HANA RISE, which is offered as a Cloud based Software Service (SaaS – Software As A Service model). While the SAP-ECC is a perpetual license based software application which is installed in the TGTRANSCO Data Centre at Vidyut Soudha, the S/4 HANA RISE is subscription based Cloud Service with a number of distinct service components which bundles hardware and software costs and offers multiple add-on/optional software services with different licensing metrics.
4. The suite of software applications and components offered as part of the S/4 HANA RISE Cloud Application would require the concerned wings to understand the nature of the software applications and to assess its suitability and usefulness to TGTRANSCO. This would require experienced senior officers to interact closely with M/s SAP consultants to understand various aspects of the application and to ascertain their compatibility with and desirability for TGTRANSCO's business practices.

5. In view of the above, an ERP Steering Committee (E-SCOM) is herewith constituted comprising of experienced senior officers across different wings of TGTRANSCO to study the proposals for migration to S/4 HANA RISE in detail through interactions with M/s SAP and the ERP Core Team. Based on these interactions, E-SCOM shall make informed recommendations to the Board on software/hardware components under different functional Modules and their quantum to be included under the scope of the S/4 HANA migration project. Further, the E-SCOM shall be to be an empowered standing committee post HANA migration to deliberate and take policy decisions on changes and improvements in the Business Processes and the SAP HANA ERP System so as to streamline and improve the efficiency of the day to day business transactions. The following members shall be members of ERP Steering Committee:

6. The following are the terms of reference for the proposed ERP Steering Committee:

- (a) The proposed ERP Steering Committee shall replace the existing SAP Governance Committee formed vide TOO cited above and the earlier committee stands dissolved.
- (b) The Committee shall study various software license and Cloud infrastructure component Bill of Materials proposed by M/s SAP for migration to S/4 HANA TISE and make recommendations along with justification for the consideration of the Board.
- (c) The committee is empowered to take any such decisions that may be necessary to simplify the existing business procedures which will lead to removal of difficulties

- and overall improvement and speeding up of business processes during the process of migration to S/4 HANA Rise and also after go-live on HANA Cloud Platform.
- (d) The business process changes made by the Committee must not alter the existing delegation of powers or core regulations of TGTRANSCO. In case such changes are inevitable, then the Committee shall obtain Board's approval for the same.
 - (e) The business process changes communicated by the ERP Steering Committee are binding on all the stakeholders across all the wings of TGTRANSCO.
 - (f) The Committee is to function in paperless mode i.e., all the minutes/decisions of the Committee are to be published on the ERP Bulletin Board and other communications will only be through official email.
 - (g) The committee may, at its discretion invite any other officer/external consultant (without financial commitment) as special invitee if the subject under discussion requires their expert opinion for taking a decision.
 - (h) The quorum for the meetings of Committee is five members excluding special invitees, if any.
 - (i) The Committee may constitute adhoc Sub-Committees comprising of members from within or outside the ERP Steering Committee for examining specific issues and to submit a report/ recommendations to the Committee for taking final decision.
 - (j) The concerned Director may nominate a new member to the Standing Committee in the event of promotion / retirement of an existing member of the Committee.
